How Do I Qualify?

You must be at least age 60 and own and live in the home for which the work is requested.

Payment is based on a sliding fee scale. Financial information is required only when requesting a reduced payment rate.

Estimates and recommendations are free. The estimate fee is included in your fee only if you choose to have Home Handyman do the work.

An easy-to-complete application is required to begin service. Assistance is available upon request.
