TITLE: Federal Highway Stimulus Funds Projects

APPLICANT: Public Works and Utilities

REASON FOR LEGISLATION: To provide authority for the Mayor to execute a Funding Agreement between the City of Lincoln and the State of Nebraska, Department of Roads, so that the identified projects will be eligible for Federal Highway Stimulus Funds provided by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA).

DISCUSSION

The City of Lincoln Public Works and Utilities proposes the following project to be eligible for funding by Federal Highway Stimulus Funds:

Antelope Valley N/S Road – P to Vine, State Project No. LCLC-55(168), CN 11215M, City Project No. 780113, JAVA Project No. 880113

The State has agreed to reimburse the City, using Federal Highway Stimulus Funds, for 100% of the actual eligible project costs up to a maximum of \$9,358,051. Local funds already programmed for Antelope Valley will be used to complete arterial rehab projects.

POLICY OR PROGRAM CHANGE: No

COST OF CONSTRUCTION: Estimated Construction and Construction Engineering for the project is \$4,570,000.
