## D I S C U S S I O N

An Environmental Assessment was written for the Southeast Area Fringe Roadways to satisfy requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act. A Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) was issued July 15, 1998. Following the FONSI the City passed Ordinance Number 17366 on June 29, 1998. The ordinance reflected the design elements described in the Environmental Assessment and FONSI.

Since 1998 traffic volumes have increased significantly due to land use changes and design features identified in the EA for the future, such as dual left-turn lanes, are required now, thus necessitating the need to amend Ordinance 17366 to reflect these needs.

Director of Public Works and Utilities is notifying Council of significant changes in conditions, as outlined in the last paragraph of Section 4 of Ordinance 17366, and request this amendment.
