REASON FOR LEGISLATION:

AN ORDINANCE amending Section 10.16.030 of the Lincoln Municipal Code, relating to penalties for driving under the influence of alcoholic liquor, to conform with recent changes in the state law by increasing the period of an operator's license revocation from one year to 18 months for a second offense DUI and requiring an ignition interlock device to be installed on any motor vehicle owned or operated by a person convicted of a second offense DUI for at least one year; and repealing Section 10.16.030 of the Lincoln Municipal Code as hitherto existing.
