REASON FOR LEGISLATION: To provide authority for the Mayor to execute a supplemental agreement between the City of Lincoln and E&A Consulting Group to provide additional design phase services for the So. 56th Street, Shadow Pines Drive to Old Cheney Road project.

DISCUSSION

The City of Lincoln (City) proposes to reconstruct 56th Street between Shadow Pines Drive and Old Cheney Road from an existing two-lane roadway to a four-lane divided roadway with turn lanes. The City and E&A Consulting Group entered into an agreement under Resolution 86642 on December 15, 2011. Additional scope and fee is necessary for additional right-of-way staking necessary for land acquisition and utility relocation associated with the project. Additional scope and fee is also included in this supplement for redesign of project features due to right-of-way negotiations associated with one tract. The Nebraska Department of Roads agrees to use the City's Federal Transportation Funds for up to 80% of the actual cost of federal aid eligible items.
