Topic: "Riding the Age Wave in Lincoln and Lancaster County: How do departments prepare?"



This presentation outlines age projections specific to Lancaster County over the next 5-20 years, provides insight on what kinds of impacts that could have on all city/county departments and will include recommendations on ways that departments can prepare for the significant increases in older adults that can be expected.

Program Speaker - Dr. Christopher Kelly - Associate Professor, UNO Department of Gerontology



Christopher M. Kelly is an Associate Professor in the Department of Gerontology at the University of Nebraska at Omaha. Dr. Kelly's research explores indicators of nursing home quality, as well as innovative long-term care alternatives at the state and local levels. The latter efforts include working with public and private stakeholders to develop home and community-based services. Dr. Kelly, along with colleagues in the UNO Gerontology Department and the UNO Center for Public Affairs Research, is a member of the Elder Care Workforce Research Triangle. With his colleagues at UNO and at Georgia State University, he continues to explore efforts to improve long-term quality, particularly through the recruitment and retention of direct care workers in home care and in assisted living. Finally, Dr. Kelly's research also explores end-of-life decision-making.
