

## WATER METER REPAIR WORKER II

### NATURE OF WORK

This is skilled work in the maintenance, repair and testing of water meters, remote readers and backflow prevention devices.

Work involves responsibility for the maintenance, repair and adjustment and testing of water meters, and the testing and repair of backflow prevention devices. An employee of this class performs a major portion of the repairs on the larger and more complex water meters and backflow prevention devices. Work is performed according to an established routine and supervision is received from the Water Meter Shop Supervisor.

### EXAMPLES OF WORK PERFORMED

Tests, disassembles, cleans, repairs, reassembles and retests water meters of all sizes and makes.

Tests, disassembles, cleans, repairs, reassembles and retests backflow prevention devices of all sizes.

Performs some work in the field on large or special meters.

Salvages usable parts of worn-out meters and stores such parts in bins for future use.

Assists in training Water Meter Worker I's in the repair of meters and backflow prevention devices.

Performs related work as required.

### DESIRABLE KNOWLEDGES, ABILITIES AND SKILLS

Considerable knowledge of methods, materials, and techniques required in repairing and testing water meters and backflow prevention devices.

Skill in the use of hand tools and small machines to perform bench work repair.

Skill in the use of water and backflow prevention testing devices.

Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions.

### DESIRABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE

Graduation from a senior high school or equivalent plus considerable experience in mechanical repair work including experience in the repair and testing of water meters and backflow prevention devices.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Graduation from a senior high school or equivalent plus experience in the repair and testing of water meters and backflow prevention devices or any equivalent combination of training and experience which provides the desirable knowledges, abilities and skills.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENT

Possession of a valid State of Nebraska driver's license when operating a vehicle is necessary for the satisfactory performance of assigned duties.
