REASON FOR LEGISLATION: To provide authority for the Mayor to execute a resolution to approve the multi-year City of Lincoln Construction Management System Upgrade between the City of Lincoln and Aurigo Software Technologies, Inc. A multi-year funding resolution is required to lock in pricing over the course of the 4 year contract and necessitates approval by the City Council.

D I S C U S S I O N

Aurigo was selected as the Engineering Services construction contract management software to help deliver \$42 million CIP program projects via a formal RFP process in 2005. Currently we are still using the 2005 version of the Aurigo Construction Management System Software.

Upgrading this software is necessary to support current computers in use by internal project observation staff and consultants contracted for the purpose of managing the various construction contracts and documenting conditions and efforts for the same.
