REASON FOR LEGISLATION: Approve a resolution for the signing of a Project Programming Agreement between the City of Lincoln and the State of Nebraska Department of Roads (NDOR) setting out the various duties and funding responsibilities for this Federal-aid project.

D I S C U S S I O N

The City of Lincoln and NDOR wish to enter into an agreement which establish the responsibilities and funding requirements for the construction of safety improvements at the intersection of U.S. Highway 6 (West "O" Street) and West 40th Street in the City of Lincoln. The safety improvements at this intersection will consist of the addition of right turn lanes and left turn lanes. The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has agreed to provide safety funds to cover 90% of the total project costs with the City providing the remaining 10%.
