

TRANSIT DEVELOPMENT PLAN



The primary goal of the StarTran Transit Development Plan (TDP) is to improve transit service in Lincoln. Convenient and cost-effective transit service requires an appropriate balance of coverage, frequency, and service span. Prior to developing any recommendations, existing ridership, on-time performance, travel patterns, and demographic data were analyzed. Public meetings and a survey indicated that later service, more frequent service, and more direct service are some of the improvements desired most.
