

# Federal/State Requirements

- Develop and implement strategies for best management practices
- **Have an enforceable ordinance requiring the implementation of post-construction standards**
- Ensure long term operation and maintenance of best management practices
- Determine best management practices and goals for the post-construction program

# Lincoln's Current NPDES Stormwater Permit Requires:

- Must provide a program to control stormwater from new development and redeveloped sites of one acre or more
- Must adopt post-construction stormwater standards for designing, installing, implementing and maintaining stormwater control measures

# Lincoln's Current NPDES Stormwater Permit Requires:

- Must adopt post-construction water quality ordinances that address new developments and redevelopments
- Must provide and adopt maintenance procedures in Lincoln's Drainage Criteria Manual
- Deadline: 9/1/2013

# Why Act Now?

- National Stormwater Rulemaking Schedule:
  - Proposed stormwater rule release is June 10, 2013
  - Final stormwater rule release planned for December 10, 2014
- If Lincoln acts before new rules are in place, Lincoln's program will likely be accepted for current permit, which expires 12/31/2017
- Current NPDES stormwater permit requires ordinances by 9/1/13

# CWTF Charge:

- Formulate recommendations for post-construction clean water program that includes:
  - Post-construction best management practices for new and redevelopment projects
  - Post-construction water quality ordinances that address new developments and redevelopments
- CWTF work completed in 2012 with final report recommendations
