

ORDINANCE NO. _____

1 AN ORDINANCE amending Section 6.12.120 of the Lincoln Municipal Code
2 relating to license fees for cats to increase the fee for licensing a cat; and repealing Section 6.12.120
3 of the Lincoln Municipal Code as hitherto existing.

4 BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

5 Section 1. That Section 6.12.120 of the Lincoln Municipal Code be amended to read
6 as follows:

7 **6.12.120 License Fee.**

8 (a) The license fee for all cats shall be the sum of thirty-four dollars; provided, however,
9 the license fee for all spayed female cats and neutered male cats shall be the sum of ~~fifteen~~ seventeen
10 dollars. Further provided, the license fee for a cat owned by an individual sixty-two years of age or
11 older shall be the sum of twenty-~~five~~ eight dollars. However, the license fee shall be ~~twelve~~ fourteen
12 dollars if the cat is a spayed female or a neutered male. Unless previously licensed as spayed or
13 neutered, a cat shall be so licensed only if the license fee is accompanied by a statement signed by
14 a veterinarian describing such cat and verifying the fact that such cat has been spayed or neutered.

15 (b) In addition to the license fee, any expired license which is renewed later than the
16 expiration date shall not be renewed or issued until the following late fee penalty has been paid by
17 the owner:

18 Received later than thirty days after license expiration,
19 but before sixty days \$ 5.00

20 Received sixty days or more after license expiration,
21 but before ninety days \$10.00

22 Received ninety days or more after license expiration \$15.00

1 For new licenses, the owner shall be liable for a late fee according to the above schedule if
2 the owner fails to license the animal within thirty days of the date the animal attains the age of six
3 months.

4 No late fee shall be charged on new licenses if the owner submits proof of purchase or
5 acquisition of the cat within the preceding thirty days; or the owner has moved into the city within
6 the preceding thirty days.

7 Section 2. That Section 6.12.120 of the Lincoln Municipal Code as hitherto existing
8 be and the same is hereby repealed.

9 Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
10 passage and publication according to law.
