Current Data: (as of 12/20/10)

- \$1,260,552 – Has been given to 70 different agencies.
- \$907,066 - Remains in escrow.
- \$81,351 – Amount requested from 14 agencies (Round 33).
- \$30,900 – Available for Round 33.

Action Requested: To approve \$30,900 to be allocated to the following 7 agencies to provide prevention programming in Lincoln/Lancaster County.

1. (C3) Bright Lights Amount: \$1,850  
To promote need based scholarships for 2011 classes serving 386 students; 15% of which are youth of color.
2. (C2) Heartland Big Brothers Big Sisters Amount: \$3,750  
To provide 119 Latino youth a mentoring program in collaboration with El Centro and LPS.
3. (NEW) Lancaster County Medical Society Foundation Amount: \$5,000  
To provide free medical telephone interpretation to People's Health Center, Wagey Drug, Lincoln/Lancaster County Health Department and LMS Physicians. They receive 80-90 calls/month.
4. (NEW) Bryan LGH Medical Center Foundation Amount: \$3,500  
Providing an estimated 400 low income clients annually who are uninsured/underinsured, health care access in emergency rooms for non-emergent reasons. *Without using*
5. (NEW) Friendship Home Amount: \$7,500  
To support 48 moms (ages 24-under) with children, in providing parenting classes on site. 76% of the families are families of color.

6. (NEW) Voices of Hope

Amount: \$7,500

To provide education on preventing domestic violence and its affects on children, to 150 moms (250 children).

7. (NEW) Community CROPS

Amount: \$1,800

To work with 100 low income youth from McPhee, Park and Everett, about hands-on gardening.

On January 7, 2011, these were approved by the Joint Budget Committee.


