### NEBRASKA GENERAL EMERGENCY SUCCESSION ACT ADOPTED

#### **2.50.010 Provisions Invoked by City.**

Pursuant to the authorization of Article III, Section 29, of the Constitution of the State of Nebraska, the provisions of the Nebraska General Emergency Succession Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 84-1101 - 84-1116 (Reissue 1987) are invoked within and for the City of Lincoln. (Ord. 15398 §1; January 8, 1990: P.C. §2.66.010: Ord. 7589 §1; October 23, 1961).

#### **2.50.020 Offices Affected**

The provisions of the Nebraska General Emergency Succession Act shall apply to and be binding upon all offices and officers of the City of Lincoln, including but not limited to, the following: Mayor, Council members, Finance Director, Parks and Recreation Director, Personnel Director, Planning Director, Director of Public Works and Utilities, City Attorney, Chief of Police, Fire Chief, Health Director, Purchasing Agent, City Clerk, City Treasurer, and City Engineer. #### **2.50.030 Filing Authority for Appointments of Alternates.**

The filing authority for the appointments of the alternates to the powers and duties of the offices shall be the City Clerk. (Ord. 15398 §3; January 8, 1990: P.C. §2.66.030: Ord. 7589 §2; October 23, 1961).
