

## Chapter 8.10

### CONSTRUCTION SITE TOILET FACILITIES

#### **8.10.010**      **Suitable Toilet Facilities for Workers or Persons Employed Required.**

Any person engaged in the erection, construction, or alteration of any building, pavement, railroad, railway, sewer, excavation, pipeline, bridge, and all public works in the city shall provide suitable and sufficient toilet facilities for the workers and persons employed in and about said construction, erection, or alteration. #### **8.10.020**      **Toilet Facilities to be Ready for Use at Time Work is Commenced.**

The toilet facilities mentioned in Section 8.10.010 shall be provided and ready for use at the time the work on the above-mentioned construction, erection, or alteration shall be commenced. (Ord. 15552 §2; May 14, 1990: P.C. §8.60.020: Ord. 3489 §15-202; July 6, 1936).

#### **8.10.030**      **Toilet Facilities Defined.**

Toilet facilities shall mean water closets with a connection to the sanitary sewer system of the city; provided, that if such construction, erection, or alteration is not accessible to a sanitary sewer, toilet facilities shall mean a chemical toilet or a suitable substitute for the same. Such toilet facilities shall comply with applicable city codes and regulations and shall be kept and maintained in a clean and sanitary condition at all times, and upon the completion of such construction, erection, or alteration, the same shall be removed in the manner provided in Chapter 24.38 for the removal of contents of cesspools.
