## FACT SHEET

**TITLE:** Paving District: West Benton Street, West of North 1st Street approximately 600 feet.

**SPONSOR:** Public Works & Public Utilities

**REASON FOR LEGISLATION:** To provide the authority to create a paving district, that being West Benton Street, West of North First Street approximately 600 feet +/- and assess the costs thereof against the benefitted properties.

## DISCUSSION

The petitioners request the paving of West Benton from the East end that being North First Street along and to the existing pavement being 600 feet +/- West. The petitioners would like to see this area completed and if they are not able to secure the necessary majority of frontage needed to advance this district on to resolution stage, they would like to see the area completed under "GAP" paving.

This area may qualify for C.D.B.G. funding.

This area would also qualify for GAP paving if the petitioner is not successful in obtaining the necessary majority of frontage to order the district constructed within the time frame allowed.
