1 WHEREAS, Art IV, § 8 of the Lincoln Charter grants the City Council certain examination
2 and review powers concerning any subject upon which it may legislate or the operations of any
3 department engaged in the administration of City affairs; and

4 WHEREAS, the City Council believes that there may exist efficiencies to be gained in
5 department audits of the City of Lincoln to compare fees and services provided to the public to
6 similar cities and of the Building and Safety Department to explore whether there exist
7 opportunities to re-cast the role of code enforcement to be more service oriented; and

8 WHEREAS, pursuant to Lincoln Municipal Code § 4.66.040, the City Performance Audit
9 Committee has certain responsibilities, including, when directed to do so by resolution of the
10 City Council, determining whether an audit as suggested in the Council's resolution is
11 appropriate and desirable, and to determine what the scope of such audit should be.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

13 That the City Council hereby directs the City Performance Audit Committee to determine
14 whether department audits of the City of Lincoln to compare fees and services provided to the
15 public to city fees and services present in similar cities and of the Building and Safety
16 Department to explore whether there exist opportunities to re-cast the role of code enforcement
17 to be more service oriented is appropriate and desirable.
