Minimum Requirements to Join Our Team:

- United States Citizen
- High School Graduate or GED Equivalency
- Nineteen (19) Years of Age or Older
- No Felony Convictions
- Valid Driver's License
- Eyesight requirements: strong eye 20/40, Correctable to 20/20, and weak eye 200/100, corrected to 20/40, must not be color blind
- Good Physical Condition
- Speak, Read, and Write English

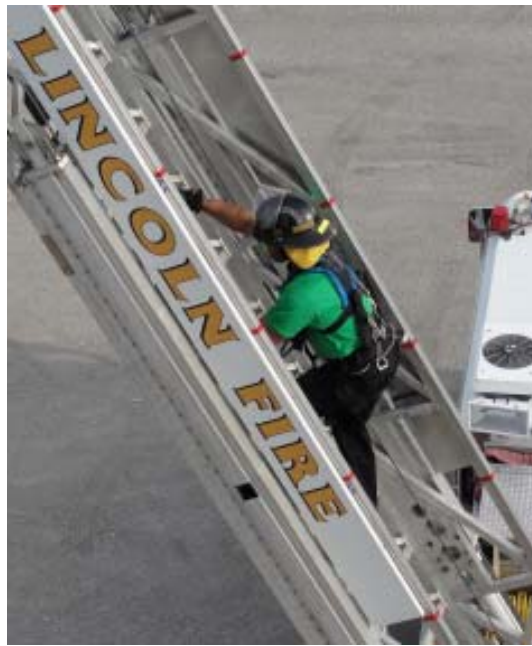
Application Process:

- Written exam: measures cognitive skills (ie., verbal comprehension and expression, math, reasoning) and behavioral attributes (ie., stress tolerance, team orientation, motivation).
- Physical Examination: each candidate must complete all phases of the physical ability test successfully as prescribed by LF&R event criteria. Events include: charged line advance, forcible entry simulation, equipment carry simulation, ceiling breach and pull, ladder heel, ladder raise, stair climb with equipment, and victim rescue (dummy drag).

Employment with LF&R provides an opportunity to experience personal growth and advancement, while engaged in a profession vital to the safety of the community. All training provided by LF&R.

Working Hours:

Shift work averages 56 hours per week on a 24 hour basis. LF&R employees work thirteen days every other day and then have eight consecutive days off known as Kelly days. This cycle takes a total of 21 days.
