<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 3,557 children were screened in 40 Lincoln public elementary schools, targeting children that have not reported seeing a dentist in the past 12 months. Program is in collaboration with Lincoln Public Schools and volunteer community dentists. 124 children were identified with urgent dental needs. An additional 214 children were screened from rural schools.</li> </ul>
