
All classes are held in the lower level training center at 3140 N Street

English Serve/Clean (SC) permit good for 2 years, costs \$20

Serve/Clean (SC) Food Handlers would include staff of establishments that do not prepare/serve potentially hazardous foods. This permit is for bakers, bussing staff, dishwashers, wait staff and convenience store workers who do not prepare or cook potentially hazardous foods, bartenders, hosting staff, and baristas.

Classes are no longer scheduled for the Serve/Clean permit. This training is available online. Alternatively, food handlers can attend a Prep/Cook (PC) class which includes the instruction required for an SC permit and costs the same. If the PC option does not meet the food handler’s needs, call (402) 441-6222 to make arrangements for one-on-one training.

English Restricted/Shift Manager (RS) permit good for 2 years, costs \$20

Tests are only available in English.

Shift managers can be in charge of an establishment that serves potentially hazardous food and may be the person-in-charge when the Food Protection Manager is not present; a regularly scheduled restaurant shift manager would be an example.

Restricted managers work in establishments that *do not* prepare and serve potentially hazardous food; examples would be bar managers, coffee shop managers, and bakery managers.

The holder of an RS permit can perform all the duties of a Prep/Cook *and* a Serve/Clean permit holder.

Translators

Food handlers who cannot read or speak English or food handlers with visual or hearing disabilities should arrange to have an interpreter come with them. LLCHD can provide translation or interpretation services, *but food handlers must make the request at least one week before class.*

English Prep/Cook (PC) permit good for 2 years, costs \$20

Prep/Cook (PC) Food Handlers would work in establishments that prepare and serve potentially hazardous foods. This permit is for chefs, cooks, salad prep staff, buffet line staff, deli staff, wait staff who help with cooking or stocking buffet lines or related tasks, all employees of fast food establishments, and convenience store clerks who prepare foods such as hot dogs.

The holder of a Prep/Cook permit can perform the duties of a Serve/Clean permit holder.

Special Needs

People with special needs (learning or developmental limitations) may call the Food Handler Education Coordinator at (402) 441-6222 to schedule one-on-one training. (Usually only provided for Serve/Clean training.)

Online Food Handler and Responsible Beverage Server/Seller Training and Permits

Employees can access the online training for both food handler and beverage server/seller permits from the Food Safety web site. Go to the InterLine home page (<http://www.lincoln.ne.gov>) and type the word “food” or “alcohol” in the search box. Click on “Search.” On the Food Safety web page, click on the “FBST” button. Read the instructions for getting started. Upon completion of the training, you will be issued a permit you can print any time as long as it has not expired.

For a Serve/Clean (SC) permit, complete Unit 1 in the online food handler training. For a Prep/Cook (PC) permit, complete Units 1 *and* 2. For a Restricted/Shift (RS) Manager permit, complete all three units. The Lincoln-Lancaster County Health Department (LLCHD) urges food handlers to complete a higher permit than you need; the cost is the same and all permits are valid for two (2) years. Renew your permit one month **before** the current permit expires.

All employees who serve or sell alcoholic beverage in Lincoln must obtain a Responsible Beverage Server Training (RBST) certificate. Select the RBST training. You must complete both the RBST general training and the City of Lincoln Server/Seller (LNK) permit. Read the instructions for getting started. The LNK permit costs \$15 and is valid for three (3) years.

Food Protection Manager (FPM) Permit: 3 years—\$30

The Lincoln Food Code requires that at least one person in charge of a Lincoln food establishment that prepares and serves potentially hazardous foods have a Food Protection Manager Permit issued by the LLCHD.

First, obtain certifications from an accredited ANSI/CFP exam (e.g., ServSafe, Prometric, National Registry, or 360Training). Some training is available online. Verify that there is a local proctored test site before paying for or taking the online training. There may be separate costs of the courses and the exams.

University of Nebraska-Lincoln. The University of Nebraska-Lincoln offers the ServSafe™ classes each month at daVinci’s at 11th and G Street. Registration website: go.unl.edu/serv or <http://cehs15.unl.edu/ccp/food/>. All classes begin at 8:30 AM with the test given at 4:30 PM. Class Fee is \$145 and includes the textbook and lunch. Class Fee if participant has the 6th Edition of the book is \$80 (lunch included). Fee for test only is \$80. Call 402-472-3716 or email nhs@unl.edu.

Second, bring the certification to the LLCHD office, complete an application, and pay the \$30 fee.

FPM Renewal Classes

Food Protection Manager (FPM) permits must be renewed *prior* to the expiration date by attending a Food Protection Manager Permit Renewal Class. This class will add three (3) years to the *end* of your permit’s current expiration date. Registration information is sent to FPMs whose permit is within one year of expiring.

Classes are scheduled on odd numbered months. They alternate between mornings and afternoons.

Upcoming dates are:

Thursday, November 17. Registration is from 12:30-1:00 pm; class is from 1:00-4:30 pm.

Monday, January 23. Registration is from 7:30-8:00 am; class is from 8:00-11:30 am.

Monday, March 20. Registration is from 12:30-1:00 pm; class is from 1:00-4:30 pm.

Failure to renew an FPM permit prior to expiration will require the manager to retake the certification training and bring the new certificate to the LLCHD for a new permit.
