Respite care offers brief, temporary periods of relief or rest for the family members, guardians or other people who are regular caretakers. This service can be offered in the private home or in a facility for various hours during the day or several days of the week.

Volunteer In-home Respite Care

Senior Volunteers are trained to provide companion-ship and supervision for elderly or disabled people for a few hours per week while the regular caregiver takes a break. There is no charge for using these respite programs.
