The Lincoln City Golf Courses have a long and successful history of providing golfing opportunities to the citizens of Lincoln and the surrounding area. The golf program has for many years been a self sufficient, independent enterprise fund with all monies received going back in to the golf fund.

All Lincoln City Golf Courses are open to the public 362 days a year with the exception of the Ager Golf Course, which is open April 1st through October 31st. At times, any of the five courses may have a special event scheduled, which may affect the availability of the course for play. Therefore, it is always a good idea to call ahead or visit parks.lincoln.ne.gov/golf.

Tee times can be reserved at the four regulation, 18-hole golf courses, up to one week in advance, for two to five players at www.lincoln.ne.gov keyword "golf". Tee times are not taken at the Ager Golf Course and golfers are started using a first come, first served system. Junior golfers also have priority over adults when starting the course.

All Lincoln City Golf Courses have full service professional golf shops, staffed by knowledgeable P.G.A. Golf Professionals. Every type of service is available, from full service tournament operations, custom golf clubs and beginning to advanced golf instruction.

Pioneers Golf Course, 3403 W. Van Dorn, 441-8966

In the late 1920's Pioneers Golf Course was built within Pioneers Park. The course, which was originally constructed as a 27-hole facility, was later reduced to its current 18-hole layout and is Lincoln's oldest municipal golf course. It is of championship length and has undergone several renovations, upgrades and modernizations since its initial development.

Holmes Park Golf Course, 3701 S. 70th St., 441-8960

The second 18-hole municipal golf course to be developed by the City of Lincoln was Holmes Park Golf Course, opening in the middle 1960's. It was developed on land purchased near Holmes Lake in southeast Lincoln. This course is also a championship length, 18-hole golf course, and has undergone renovations in many areas since its initial construction.

Mahoney Golf Course, 7900 Adams St., 441-8969

The third golf course developed by the City was Mahoney Park Golf Course, which opened in the middle 1970's. It also is a championship length, 18-hole golf course, and is located in northeast Lincoln.

Highlands Golf Course, 5501 NW 12th St., 441-6081

The fourth and newest 18-hole golf course developed by the City of Lincoln, is the Highlands Golf Course, located in northwest Lincoln. The Highlands course was developed and opened in 1993 and is a championship links style 18-hole golf course. Development of the Highlands Golf Course completed an established goal of providing an 18-hole, municipal golf course in each quadrant of the city.

Jim Ager Golf Course, 3761 Normal Blvd., 441-8963

In addition to the four 18-hole golf courses, the city owns and operates the Jim Ager Memorial Golf Course, near downtown. It is a 9-hole, par 3 golf course, and opened in 1965. The course includes all the features present on a championship course, but on a scale more suitable to youth, seniors and any golfers that are developing basic skills.
