In accordance to Legal Opinion § 2.76.220 of the Lincoln Municipal Code, the minimum hiring age shall be 14 years of age unless otherwise stated.

### **"CONDITION OF EMPLOYMENT"**

"In accordance with the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986, all employers are required to document your eligibility for employment. Each individual who is offered employment must submit original documents which establish employment authorization and identity within three (3) working days of employment. If the individual is hired for less than three working days, the forms must be completed by the first day of work. Failure to comply will result in termination or withdrawal of the offer of employment."

### CAMP COUNSELOR (3)

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Experience teaching children nature; ability to work in an outdoor setting. Previous camp counseling experience and natural science knowledge helpful. Will be required to drive a van. Must possess a valid driver's license and must have an excellent driving record.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** Conduct and participate in nature activities for children who have completed K-6th grade. Assist in curriculum development and program planning, supervise participants and deal with any discipline problems.

## VISITOR SERVICES STAFF

### VISITOR SERVICES (2)

\$8.00 - \$8.75 per hour; variable hours per week (12 to 20, including weekends) - June 1 - August 17.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Ability to work with and talk to people of all ages and capabilities, have some knowledge of the flora and fauna of Nebraska, and a willingness to work with a flexible schedule.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** Greet visitors, and perform basic care of exhibits, including small animals.

### Natural Resources Season Workers (2)

\$8.25 - \$9.50 per hour. Available generally between 7:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, 40 hours per week. April – September.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Must be able to perform manual labor. Work with the Saline Wetlands Conservation Partnership and on other natural areas. Applicants must be 18 years of age, have a valid Nebraska Driver's License. Applicants must be in good physical health, able to work outdoors in all types of conditions with limited supervision, and have an interest in the conservation of natural areas.

## SPECIAL POPULATIONS SUMFUN DAY CAMP

All applicants are required to be High School graduates under the State OMR regulations, and at least 19 years of age by July 1, 2009.

**RECREATION GROUP LEADER/INSTRUCTOR (12)**

\$7.70 per hour; approximately 8:00 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Starts July 6, ends August 7.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Prefer individuals majoring in Special Education, Recreation, Physical Education, Art, Music or related fields. Applicants should have interest and experience in working with children with special needs in an outdoor setting and the ability to instruct them in crafts, games, music, drama or nature lore. Must be physically able to perform all duties related to leading physical activities including active participation and interaction with children with special needs. Staff will work in teams of two to pick up participants and take them home. Applicants must have an excellent driving record and a valid NE driver’s license.

**RECREATION DAY CAMP DIRECTORS/LEADERS:**

\$7.40-\$8.80 per hour, depending on position. Variable hours available between 6:45 a.m. – 6:15 p.m., Monday through Friday, 20-40 hrs. per week.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Must be available for training session June 2-4 and for entire program period June 8-August 14. Mature individual with outgoing personality and ability to relate to children and youth. Possess the ability to plan and conduct a recreation program for grade school or middle school youth. Previous experience working in a leadership role with groups of children is desirable. Have to be physically able to perform all duties related to leading physical activities including active participation with children during these activities. A valid Nebraska driver’s license and no more than three points off in the last three years is required. Those hired will be trained to drive a Parks and Recreation van for field trips.

**DUTIES:** Will include conducting a variety of active and non-active games and sports, crafts and other recreational and/or educational activities. Supervising and participating in field trips and swimming outings is required.

**MEN'S AND WOMEN'S SOFTBALL UMPIRES (25-30)** (Need not fill out application)

\$14.00 - \$16.00 per one hour game.

Umpires needed for evening games Monday - Friday from 6:00 p.m.-10:30 p.m. and on Sunday in the afternoon and evenings. Umpires set own work hours based on availability.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Have knowledge of Standard Softball Rules and Regulations; able to enforce and interpret rules.

## AQUATICS

### SWIMMING POOLS

Applications may be picked up at the Parks and Recreation Office, 2740 "A" Street. Applications received by Feb. 6, 2009, will be reviewed first.

\* All 14 and 15-year old applicants must obtain a work permit through your School Administration Offices if chosen for a job.

**Season starts May 23 and ends August 18 for some locations. Other pools open June 6 and close August 16.**

#### POOL LIFEGUARDS (200)

\$8.00 - \$10.00 per hour. Rate of pay will vary with qualifications and experience. Approximately 37 ½ hours per week.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Must hold a current \*Lifeguard Training card and a CPR card. Pool Operator card desirable. Must be available for skill testing in April and training in May. Have ability to deal with public fairly and courteously, must be reliable. Hours vary from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily. Must be 16 years of age or older.

\* Must bring CPR, Lifeguard Training card to the interview. Please bring Pool Operator card to interview if you have it. \*Cards must be good through September 1, 2009, or be renewed before employment begins.

#### HEAD GUARD (21)

\$9.00 - \$11:00 per hour (approximately 40 hours per week).

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Must hold a current \*Lifeguard Training card and C.P.R. card. Must be available for skill testing in April and training in May. Have ability to deal fairly and courteously with the public; have knowledge of water purification methods and pool operations; must obtain and have current State Pool Operator's Certificate.

Hours will vary. Must be 19 years of age or older. \*Must bring C.P.R., Lifeguard Training and Pool Operator cards to the interview. \*Cards must be current through September 1, 2009, or be renewed before employment begins.

#### POOL CASHIERS - CONCESSION WORKERS (100)

\$6.55 - \$8.00 per hour. Approximately 15-35 hours per week.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Experienced in making change and running a cash register; ability to meet the public; courteous and reliable. Concession staff must possess a current Food Handler Permit. Hours: 11:30 a.m. - 8:30 p.m. daily. Some morning hours. Must be 14 years of age or older. \*Must obtain a work permit if not 16 by May.

#### YOUTH COMPETITIVE DIVING LEAGUE COACHES (4-8)

\$8.00 - \$10.00 per hour. Approximately 8-12 hours per week, more if hired as a lifeguard.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Must have high school or college diving experience. Must be able to work with youth (ages 6 - 18 years). Work Monday through Friday. Will schedule practices. Diving meets on Thursday evenings and weekly evening coaches meeting to be scheduled. \*Would consider diving coach as a lifeguard or cashier at one of the pools.

#### YOUTH COMPETITIVE SWIM TEAM COACHES (7-20)

\$8.00 - \$10.00 per hour. Approximately 10-20 hours per week; more if hired as a lifeguard.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Must have high school or college swimming experience; must be able to supervise 40-125 youth, ages 6 - 18 years old. Work Monday through Friday morning practices, weekly evening coaches meetings and Saturday morning swim meets.

## **PARK OPERATIONS & MAINTENANCE**

All applicants are required to be a least 16 years of age unless otherwise specified. Applications may be picked up after January 1, 2009, at the Parks and Recreation Office, 2740 "A" Street, Lincoln, NE 68502. Applications received by March 13, 2009, will be given preference.

### **SEASONAL PARKS LABORER (43) Parks (40) Golf (6) Display Gardens**

\$6.55 - \$11.25 per hour. Starts Spring - ends Fall - 40 hours per week.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Must be able to perform manual labor. Hours varied. Required to work assigned schedules, including weekends and the Holidays of Memorial Day and 4<sup>th</sup> of July. Applicants must be 18 years of age to operate most power equipment, mowers, and motor vehicles. Average of 12 to 14 weeks of work, includes some weekends and evenings. Must be in good physical health and able to work outdoors in all types of conditions. Valid Nebraska Driver's License required for most positions. Some positions require mechanical ability. Criminal history check will be done on selected applicants.
