The application closing dates and testing dates are listed below. You can test on any one of the testing dates. At that time, both written and physical ability testing will take place. Your application and supplemental questionnaire must be received by City Personnel in order to test. Applications are currently available on line at the City Personnel [Job Openings](#) site. Once at the site scroll down to police trainee and follow the directions .

The written portion of the test will occur between 0800 and 1200 each testing day. You will receive a study guide for the written portion of the exam two weeks prior to the test. This is a very important part of the hiring process. You must put forth the time and effort to study this information. The higher you score, the better your chances are of getting hired. If you do not score in a high enough 'band' you will not be eligible for further testing for the Fall 2008 Academy.

A description of the physical ability testing will also be sent to you via e-mail. You will need to be physically prepared in order to perform these tests, so plan ahead. If you don't already exercise, now is the time to start a progressive training program so you can be physically prepared to complete all of the required tests. The physical testing includes a 1.5 mile run, vertical jump, sit ups, push ups, and a 120 yard shuttle run. The physical testing will be conducted on the same day as the written test for those who qualify.

The following is the starting pay scale for officers: Police Trainee: \$2,600 per month. Police Officer: Starting pay \$3,388.02 per month. Those who are currently law enforcement certified may be paid \$40,655.68 annually at the time of hire. Based upon the demonstrated skill level, the candidate may be eligible for an accelerated Field Training Program.
