

Coordinating Professional

Section 81-3408. *Coordinating professional, defined.*

Coordinating professional means an architect or professional engineer who coordinates, as qualified, the various professional disciplines involved in a project.

Section 81-3437. *Certificate of licensure; issuance; seal; use; enrollment card; issuance.*

(g) Projects involving more than one licensed architect or professional engineer shall have one designated as the coordinating professional. The coordinating professional shall apply his or her seal and signature and the date to the cover sheet of all documents and denote the seal as that of the coordinating professional.

Guidelines for placing the Coordinating Professional's seal on City of Lincoln plans.

The Coordinating Professional's seal shall be placed in the lower right hand portion of the Cover Sheet immediately left of the "Approved for Construction" signature line. The words "Coordinating Professional" shall be placed directly below the seal.

Directly above the Coordinating Professional's seal, list the names of the engineers who have sealed sheets in the plan set and the discipline of those sheets.

(name of sealer) - Roadway/Water Main

(name of sealer) - Traffic Signals

(name of sealer) - Storm Drainage
