

The 2015 Projected Construction & Right of Way Activities



While an attempt has been made to list as many projects and activities as possible, not all things affecting the public rights of way and travel routes are probably listed. Not everything affecting streets in 2015 is known at this time, such as unscheduled maintenance and emergency repairs as may be needed.

Other work in the right of way and streets may include but is not limited to: Festivals, Preliminary Surveys, Community/Neighborhood Events, Special Assessment Districts, Private Development Construction Agreements, Lancaster County, Railroads (BNSF, UPRR, OL&B), Private Utilities – Windstream, Time Warner, Unite, Level 3, Sprint, and many others.

Community Goals / Indicators

Outcome #5 Efficient Transportation Goal #1 – Provide, maintain, and support safe, convenient, durable and efficient transportation infrastructure. Improve overall city street condition rating to “very good” by rehabilitating 46 miles of streets annually. (Estimated that 1 mile = approximately 14 blocks)

Outcome #2 Economic Opportunity Goal #4 – Annually complete 2.5 miles of major street capacity construction required to serve the 2040 City Comprehensive plan vision. (Long-Range Transportation Plan roadway needs)

Outcome #3 Healthy & Productive People Goal #2 – Increase the percentage of needed sidewalk repairs completed from 1.7% to 6.7% (1.7% is generally equal to approximately 100,000 SF of repairs)



Other Projects of note:

○ **City of Lincoln Fiber / Conduit Program**

- 46th and R – Construct new fiber connection from 66th and Lincrest to the DMV and Election Board building at 46th and R. Primary customers are County, State and PW Traffic connection upgrade. Upgrade connection from DSL at both sites to 1-gigabit fiber and add VOIP services.
- Sun Valley and W. O St. – Construct new fiber connection from the City conduit on the North East corner of W. and Sun Valley to the DMV building on the South West corner of same intersection. Primary customers are County and State. Will construct 1500' of additional conduit West on O St. from this location.
