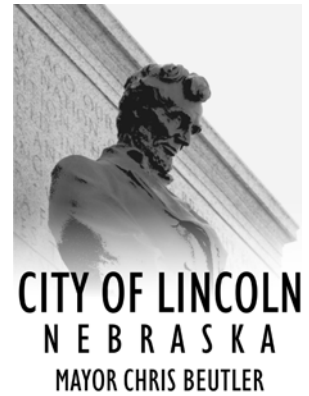


**WASTEWATER FACILITY MASTER PLAN
UPDATE - OPEN HOUSE
PRESENTATION AT 5:30
JANUARY 29, 2008**



The Wastewater Plan outlines both short and long term Wastewater infrastructure needs: collection system pipelines, pump stations, storage facilities and treatment City wide, to protect public health, safety, environment and meet future growth outlined in the City-County Comprehensive Plan.

As growth changes in Lincoln so will the timing of the planned infrastructure needs outlined in the Wastewater Plan.

Future updates to the Wastewater Plan are currently planned to occur every five years. The next update is planned to occur in 2012.

Below is the tentative schedule for proceeding forward with formal adoption of the Wastewater Facility Master Plan by the Planning Commission and the City Council:

- January Wastewater Master Plan available on website
- January 16th Planning Commission gets copies & executive summary
- January 29th **Public Open House** – Public gets opportunity to view presentation, ask questions and review master plan with staff and consultant.
- January 30th Planning Commission **Briefing** by staff on draft master plan
- Late January/
• Early February Meetings with any interested groups
Chamber of Commerce, LIBA - to present draft at their meeting with opportunity for questions and discussion with staff
- February 27th Planning Commission public hearing and potentially make recommendation on draft
- March 17th City Council Public Hearing (if Planning Comm. acts on 2/27)
