RE: Water and Sanitary Sewer Tapping Fees

Dear Plumbers and Homebuilders:

We have completed our annual review of the cost of tapping into our water and sanitary sewer systems and permit fees to ensure we are recovering the City's costs. Effective January 1, 2016, the new wastewater tap and water tap fee schedule identified below will be used.

These fees reflect the most recent price quotes for meters and automated reading modules received by the City. The permit fees for new water services include the cost of 15 units of construction water (for all sizes).
