An Evening with the Cranes

Tuesday, April 2

Cranes are among the oldest living birds on the planet. Fossil records place sandhill cranes in Nebraska more than nine million years ago. Each spring, 1,000,000 sandhill cranes converge on the Platte River in central Nebraska as they migrate north to their nesting grounds.

Join us for an evening on the North Platte River to watch them gracefully dance as they fly in to roost. We will arrive at the Rowe Sanctuary, enjoy a sack supper, then go out to the river. Feel free to bring snacks for the bus ride. We will head back to Lincoln at 8:30 p.m.

There is a quarter mile pebble walk to the blind. The following is strongly recommended for the walk: warm clothes and warm footwear, stocking cap or insulated hat, warm gloves or mittens, dress in layers, binoculars and snacks are highly recommended .
