

CONTRACT AGREEMENT**

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into this 16<sup>th</sup> day of May 2012, by and between Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc., 13915 A Plaza, Omaha, NE 68144, hereinafter called "Contractor", and the City of Lincoln, Nebraska, a municipal corporation, and the County of Lancaster, Nebraska, a political subdivision of the State of Nebraska, hereinafter called the "Owners".

WHEREAS, the Owner has caused to be prepared, in accordance with law, Specifications, Plans, and other Contract Documents for the Work herein described, and has approved and adopted said documents and has caused to be published an advertisement for and in connection with said Work, to-wit:

For the **Used Oil Collection Program, Quote No. 3959** and,

WHEREAS, the Contractor, in response to such advertisement, has submitted to the Owners, in the manner and at the time specified, a sealed Proposal/Supplier Response in accordance with the terms of said advertisement; and,

WHEREAS, the Owners, in the manner prescribed by law has publicly opened, read aloud, examined, and canvassed the Proposals/Supplier Responses submitted in response to such advertisement, and as a result of such canvass has determined and declared the Contractor to be the lowest responsible bidder for the said Work for the sum or sums named in the Contractor's Proposal/Supplier Responses, a copy thereof being attached to and made a part of this Contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sums to be paid to the Contractor and the mutual covenants herein contained, the Contractor and the Owners have agreed and hereby agree as follows:

1. The Contractor agrees to (a) furnish all tools, equipment, supplies, superintendence, transportation, and other accessories, services, and facilities; (b) furnish all materials, supplies, and equipment specified to be incorporated into and form a permanent part of the complete work; (c) provide and perform all necessary labor in a substantial and workmanlike manner and in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents; and (d) execute and complete all Work included in and covered by the Owners' award of this Contract to the Contractor, such award being based on the acceptance by the Owner of the Contractor's Proposal, or part thereof, as follows:

**Agreement to full proposal.**

2. The Owners agree to pay to the Contractor for the performance of the Work embraced in this Contract, the Contractor agrees to accept as full compensation therefore, the following sums and prices for all Work covered by and included in the Contract award and designated above, payment thereof to be made in the manner provided by the Owners:

**Owners will pay for products/service, according to the Line Item pricing as listed in Contractors Proposal/Supplier Response, a copy thereof being attached to and made a part of this Contract. Owners shall order on an as needed basis for the duration of the contract.**

3. Equal Employment Opportunity. In connection with the carrying out of this project, the contractor shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, disability, age or marital status. The Contractor will take affirmative action to ensure that applicants are employed, and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, disability, age or marital status. Such action shall include, but not be limited to, the following: employment, upgrading, demotion or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship.

4. E-Verify. In accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. 4-108 through 4-114, the contractor agrees to register with and use a federal immigration verification system, to determine the work eligibility status of new employees performing services within the state of Nebraska. A federal immigration verification system means the electronic verification of the work authorization program of the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996, 8 U.S.C. 1324 a, otherwise known as the E-Verify Program, or an equivalent federal program designated by the United States Department of Homeland Security or other federal agency authorized to verify the work eligibility status of a newly hired employee pursuant to the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986. The Contractor shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment to be employed in the performance of this section pursuant to the requirements of state law and 8 U.S.C.A 1324b. The contractor shall require any subcontractor to comply with the provisions of this section.
5. Termination. This Contract may be terminated by the following:
  - 5.1) Termination for Convenience. Either party may terminate this Contract upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party for any reason without penalty.
  - 5.2) Termination for Cause. The Owners may terminate the Contract for cause if the Contractor:
    - 5.2.1) Refuses or fails to supply the proper labor, materials and equipment necessary to provide services and/or commodities.
    - 5.2.2) Disregards Federal, State or local laws, ordinances, regulations, resolutions or orders.
    - 5.2.3) Otherwise commits a substantial breach or default of any provision of the Contract Document. In the event of a substantial breach or default the Owners will provide the Contractor written notice of said breach or default and allow the Contractor ten (10) days from the date of the written notice to cure such breach or default. If said breach or default is not cured within ten (10) days from the date of notice, then the contract shall terminate.
6. Independent Contractor. It is the express intent of the parties that this contract shall not create an employer-employee relationship. Employees of the Contractor shall not be deemed to be employees of the Owners and employees of the Owners shall not be deemed to be employees of the Contractor. The Contractor and the Owners shall be responsible to their respective employees for all salary and benefits. Neither the Contractor's employees nor the Owners' employees shall be entitled to any salary, wages, or benefits from the other party, including but not limited to overtime, vacation, retirement benefits, workers' compensation, sick leave or injury leave. Contractor shall also be responsible for maintaining workers' compensation insurance, unemployment insurance for its employees, and for payment of all federal, state, local and any other payroll taxes with respect to its employees' compensation.
7. Owner Inclusion. It is understood and agreed by all parties that "Owner/s" shall include the City of Lincoln and Lancaster County, Nebraska. Whenever in the Contract documents, including the instructions to bidders, specifications, insurance requirements, bonds, and terms and conditions or any other documents which are a part of the Contract, a singular entity is referenced (i.e., "the City" or "the County") it shall mean the "Owners" encompassing the City of Lincoln, and Lancaster County.
8. Contract Term. This Contract shall be effective upon execution by all parties. The term of the Contract shall be a **one (1) year** term with the option to renew for **three (3) additional one (1) year** periods.

9. The Contract Documents comprise the Contract, and consist of the following:
1. Contract Agreement
  2. Accepted Proposal/Response
  3. Instructions to Bidders
  4. Insurance Requirements
  5. Specifications
  6. Attachment A



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**SPECIFICATIONS  
FOR  
USED OIL COLLECTION**

**1. SCOPE OF WORK**

- 1.1 The intent of this specification is to describe the provisions of used oil collection for departments within the City of Lincoln and Lancaster County.
  - 1.1.1 Each location requiring used oil collection is listed in Attachment A.
  - 1.1.2 The list indicates tank capacity only and is not a guaranteed quantity.
  - 1.1.3 Transmission, hydraulic and gear oils may be mixed with used motor oils.
  - 1.1.4 The North 48<sup>th</sup> Street Transfer Station location accepts used oils from residents of the county.
    - 1.1.1.4 The used oils collected from residents are screened for fuel, solvent, antifreeze and water contamination.
- 1.2 Bidder shall submit bid documents and all supporting material via e-bid.
- 1.3 All inquiries regarding these specifications shall be directed in writing to Sharon Mulder, Assistant Purchasing Agent via e-mail ( [smulder@lincoln.ne.gov](mailto:smulder@lincoln.ne.gov) ) or fax ((402) 441-6513).
  - 1.3.1 These inquiries and/or responses shall be distributed to prospective bidders electronically as an addenda.
  - 1.3.2 The Purchasing Office shall only reply to written inquiries received within five (5) calendar days of bid opening.

**2. CONTRACT PERIOD**

- 2.1 A contract resulting from this bid will be issued for a period of one (1) year with the option to renew for three (3) additional one (1) year periods as mutually agreed upon by all parties.

**3. ESTIMATED QUANTITIES**

- 3.1 It shall be clearly understood by all parties that the quantities shown are given for the purpose of securing a unit price bid, and not a guarantee that they will be required under this contract.
  - 3.1.1 No bids will be considered that require definite quantities.

**4. COLLECTION SCHEDULE**

- 4.1 Used oil collection will be required at the locations listed in Attachment A.
  - 4.1.1 A representative from the collection location will contact the contractor to request service.
    - 4.1.1.2 Service must be provided within 48 hours of the request for service.
  - 4.1.2 The contractor may provide an alternate collection schedule for any location with approval from the respective contact person listed in Attachment A.
  - 4.1.3 A numbered receipt with the company's name, signed by the driver, and identifying the number of gallons collected must be left with the yard/site personnel at the time of collection.
    - 4.1.3.1 A separate receipt shall be prepared for each tank for locations that have multiple tanks.

- 4.2 Used oil collection must be made between 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M., Monday thru Friday, excluding holidays.

5. **GENERAL**

- 5.1 Payments for the used oil collections shall be sent to the contact address associated with each location within 30 days of the end of each calendar quarter.
- 5.1.1 Information accompanying the payment shall clearly identify the location(s) serviced, the date(s) of the collection, and the gallons collected.
- 5.2 The contractor shall submit a summary report of collections made during each calendar quarter.
- 5.2.1 The summary report shall be submitted within two (2) days after the end of each calendar quarter or if possible the first business day after the end of the quarter.
- 5.2.2 The report shall list each location from which used oil was collected, the receipt number(s), the date(s) of collection, the gallons collected, the check number(s) issued, the total amount paid per check, and the disposition of the collected oil.
- 5.2.3 The quarterly report shall be submitted to Gene Hanlon, Recycling Coordinator, via e-mail [ghanlon@lincoln.ne.gov](mailto:ghanlon@lincoln.ne.gov).
