SUBJ: Approval of Amendment to Lincoln's FY-2008 TIP by Governor's Designee.
City of Lincoln has a Trail Renovation project to be added to the FY-2008 TIP
City of Waverly has a Via Location Study to be added to the FY-2008 TIP.

Dear Mr. Brienzo:

As the Governor's designee, I am approving an amendment to Lincoln's current FY-2008 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) that adds the following two projects to the first year element (FY-08) of Lincoln's TIP.

These Projects were approved by Lincoln's Mayor in a letter dated April 25, 2008.

Project: RTP-2008(003) Sponsored by Lincoln's Park & Rec.
Name: Boosalis Trail Renovation (replacing old Asph with concrete).
Location: Boosalis Trail along Hwy 2 from 27th to 20th St (Phase I).
(Length= 0.5 mile, Width= 10 feet)
Funds: Federal RTP funds= \$129,100. Total cost = \$161,800.

Project: RRZ-TMT 55-(163) Sponsored by City of Waverly.
Name: Waverly Viaduct Location Study.
Location: Evaluate need for a new Via across BNSF RR on east side of Waverly.
Length= NA.
Funds: Although there are Federal funds programmed for the "Construction" of the Via in the future, there are no Federal funds available for this Location Study. Total study cost= \$107,824.

Lincoln's TIP is included in the Nebraska's STIP by reference. It will be included in Nebraska's STIP when we notify FHWA of this approval.
