Legalities

- Concrete slurry that makes it's way to the stormdrain is considered...
 1. Illicit Discharge
 2. Illegal
 3. Violation of Lincoln Municipal Code (LMC) 28.02
 4. A fineable offense by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Nebraska Department of Environmental Quality (NDEQ) as well as the City of Lincoln



Why??

Ph is too High!!

Ph of >12.5 and <2.0 are classified as hazardous

Concrete Cuttings have a ph of upwards of 15!!

Ph of 8.5 is high enough to kill some fish.



EPA considers **ALL** illicit discharges to be in violation of the
Clean Water Act (CWA)
