The Lincoln MPO Management Plan identifies the MPO organizational structure and related responsibilities of participating agencies in carrying out the federally-mandated transportation planning process in the Lincoln Planning Area. The MPO provides a forum for cooperative decision-making among local and state agencies which includes the responsibility to develop and maintain various planning documents required by the MPO. The planning process requires regular Technical Committee meetings that includes Advisory Subcommittees to assist in meeting the requirements of the transportation planning process and in developing the planning documents.
