

RESOLUTION NO. A-_____

1 WHEREAS, the City Council is authorized under Sections 17.60.020 and
 2 17.60.030 of the Lincoln Municipal code to establish wastewater charges for all customers of the
 3 Lincoln Wastewater System.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of
 5 Lincoln, Nebraska:

6 Effective with the billing cycle commencing on November 15, 2001, and ending
 7 on January 15, 2002, the following schedule of wastewater charges is hereby established and
 8 adopted:

BASIC WASTEWATER USE CHARGE

10 (a) The basic wastewater use unit charge is hereby established at 95.5 cents.

11 (b) For any given residential property, the basic wastewater use charge for
 12 each billing cycle shall be determined by multiplying for each such cycle the total amount of
 13 water, in hundreds of cubic feet, metered for said property during a billing cycle chosen by the
 14 Director from the most recent past winter, by the basic wastewater use unit charge.

15 In the case of change of occupancy of residential property, if the Director
 16 reasonably determines that to compute the basic wastewater use charge for a given billing cycle
 17 upon the amount of water used by such property during such winter billing cycle would be
 18 inequitable either to the City or to the user, he shall use the average amount of water used by like
 19 users during such winter billing cycle to compute such charge.

1 (c) For any non-residential property, the basic wastewater use charge for a
2 given billing cycle shall be determined by multiplying for each cycle the amount of water or
3 wastewater, in hundreds of cubic feet, measured for said property during such cycle, by the basic
4 wastewater use unit charge.

5 (d) Non-residential users shall be given credit, at the same rate, for water not
6 discharged into the sanitary sewers provided such water is separately metered with the approval
7 of the Public Works and Utilities Department and at the customer's expense.

8 (e) Where a wastewater flow meter or other wastewater measuring device is
9 required or permitted by the Director and is used to measure the volume of wastewater
10 discharged into the Lincoln Wastewater System, such wastewater use charge shall be computed
11 thereon at the basic wastewater use unit charge.

12 SERVICE CHARGE

13 Regardless of whether a wastewater meter is used, there shall be a service charge
14 per month to each property using the Lincoln Wastewater System, determined by the number and
15 size of the water meters serving such property, to-wit:

17	5/8 inch	\$ 2.00
18	3/4 inch	2.00
19	1 inch	2.00
20	1 1/2 inch	4.00
21	2 inch	8.00
22	3 inch	18.00
23	4 inch	32.00
24	6 inch	72.00
25	8 inch	128.00
26	10 inch	200.00

1 In those instances where fire protection considerations dictate that a water meter
2 larger than 1-inch service a single-family dwelling unit located on a single lot, the monthly
3 service charge shall be \$2.00 per dwelling unit.

4 WASTEWATER RATES TO CUSTOMERS OUTSIDE
5 THE CITY LIMITS

6 Customers located outside the city limits of Lincoln and served by the Lincoln
7 Wastewater System shall pay the same wastewater rates charged to customers within the city
8 limits of Lincoln for service furnished them by the Lincoln Wastewater System.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. A-75077 adopted by the City
10 Council on October 19, 1992 is hereby superseded.
