REASON FOR LEGISLATION: To provide the authority to approve the 2003-04 BMP and Dry Weather Storm Drainage Assessment by UNL - Civil Engineering Department to monitor urban water quality.

D I S C U S S I O N

This is a resolution to allow Public Works & Utilities to monitor urban stormwater quality, which is required through the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit requirements. This agreement will be used to have UNL - Civil Engineering Department monitor dry weather runoff at approximately 60 storm drain outfalls and to monitor and evaluate Best Management Practices (BMPs) at six sites.
