REASON FOR LEGISLATION

The City of Lincoln is applying to the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission for a Recreational Trails Program to provide financial assistance for renovation of the Murdock Trail. A resolution approved by the City Council and signed by the Mayor authorizing the application and following the grant guidelines is required for the application process.

DISCUSSION / FINDINGS OF FACT:

This project will involve the renovation of the Murdock Trail from Touzalin Ave. to 70th Street. It will require the removal of 8 feet wide crushed limestone and replacing it with 10 feet wide concrete. This will allow for a more diverse and year round use of the trail for recreational purposes.
