Taylor Wyatt was born and raised in Northeast Lincoln and attended Lincoln Lutheran where he graduated in 2005. In 2009 he obtained a degree in Education and Human Sciences from UNL. After teaching for five years he ventured into the private sector. Mr. Wyatt is now a Realtor with Keller Williams Realty. Mr. Wyatt is married with one child. He believes there is a need to prioritize the City spending in order to focus on key structures of our City which include: Fixing and improving City Streets, Equipping Police, Fire and Rescue services, improve conditions for businesses to bring quality jobs to Lincoln and keep current talent in the City while being attractive to new talent, and prevent proposed tax increases on the residents of Lincoln.

James Bowers was born and raised in Northeast Lincoln and is a Northeast High School graduate who got his start in public service volunteering at the Northeast Family Center, where he helped with food distribution. Mr. Bowers later served two terms as President of the Northeast Family Center, and has served on the board of Fresh Start, a group home for women. If elected he plans to focus on ensuring that Lincoln has a strong public safety network, solid infrastructure and is supporting a robust workforce.
