ANIMAL LICENSE APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Any person within the city limits who owns a dog or cat over 6 months of age is required to obtain a license for their pet. Rabies vaccinations are required at 3 months of age per state statutes and municipal code.

1. If **renewing** your pet license on line, please go to www.lincoln.ne.gov, type the word "tag it" in the search box and click the search button. From that page, follow the on line instructions for renewal.
2. If you are obtaining a **NEW** pet license, please go to www.lincoln.ne.gov, type in the words "pet application". Select "Animal License Application" from the "APPLICATIONS" list. If you are currently reading this on line, the application is on the next page within this document. Please read steps 3 and 4, prior to proceeding.
3. If submitting your application electronically, **fill out the application form online, save it to your computer and email the completed application with a picture of the current rabies certificate as attachments to PetLicensing@lincoln.ne.gov. If your pet has been spayed or neutered, please attach that verification as well.**
4. If submitting by USPS, you may fill out the form on line and then print the application. Enclose the completed form, a non-returnable copy of the rabies vaccination, spay/neuter verification (if applicable) and the corresponding fees shown within the application fee table. Mail the envelope and entire contents with appropriate postage to:

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5. Email a completed application attaching a picture of the current rabies certificate. If your pet has been spayed or neutered, please include that verification. If using USPS, enclose the completed application, a non-returnable copy of the rabies vaccination and spay/neuter verification.
6. Municipal code requires you to notify us if you no longer have your pet. Please call 402-441-7900.
7. Fees payable to **ANIMAL CONTROL**.
8. Please allow 2 - 3 weeks for processing via USPS.
9. If your pet has a microchip, write the number next to the pets name.

- License tags are not transferable from one owner or animal to another. Lost tags are replaced for \$5.00, if your pet is currently licensed.
- A license fee may be prorated for your convenience.
- Put the tag on your pet's collar!
- A rabies tag is not a license. With a license, Animal Control can contact you if pet is lost or injured.
