

# 2017 UpStream Art – Lincoln Rules and Regulations

## Artwork Submissions

- Designs **MUST** have the message “Only Rain in the Drain” incorporated into the artwork, either by itself or as part of a longer message. Writing may be in English or English/Spanish (bilingual).
- Designs should have a water or water quality-related theme.
- Native wildlife that live in or near the water and their habitat are encouraged, but not required.
- Designs of a political, religious, sexual or controversial nature or designs that depict images of illegal activity are prohibited.
- Designs may not include any breach of intellectual property or brands/trademarks.
- Designs may not contain any business promotions or advertisements.
- Sketches should indicate how the design will be placed in relation to the storm drain features.
- Artwork is to be original and submitted by its creator.
- Limit one submission per person. The program is limited to local artists, age 19 or older.
- Inappropriate designs will be rejected at the sole discretion of the City of Lincoln’s Watershed Management Division and excluded from the selection process.
- All artwork submissions will become property of the City of Lincoln. The City of Lincoln reserves the right to reproduce artwork submissions for promotional and archival purposes. However, intellectual property of the design will remain with the artist.

## 2017 UpStream Art – Lincoln Artists

- Artists will be notified by June 30, 2017 if their artwork has been chosen for the 2017 UpStream Art – Lincoln Program.
- Artists chosen to participate in the program must sign the artist agreement. An example of this document may be found on the Upstream Art – Lincoln website.
- Artwork must be installed by the artist between **July 17 and July 23, 2017**. Anyone submitting an application should plan to be available to install their artwork (if their design is chosen) during this timeframe.
- Artists must use the approved 100% acrylic paint and Seal-Krete concrete sealer provided by the City of Lincoln. Materials may be picked up on July 17, 2017, 8:30am to 4:30pm.
- Artists will be required to provide their own brushes and tools (including paint containers).
- Artists must provide a bio, title, and short description of their design by July 24, 2017 to be included on the UpStream Art – Lincoln website.
