The meeting was called to order at 7:00 a.m., followed by announcement recognizing regulations of the Open Meetings Act as posted by the door.

**Minutes:** Approval of May 9, 2017 minutes: moved by Ronnau and seconded by Coble, unanimous approval.

**Staff Reports:** Hartzell explained the temporary repairs which have been made to the 48<sup>th</sup> Street and Wedgewood Lake bridges on the MoPac Trail. The plan is to return in July and replace the planks that are currently patched. Long term Parks is looking at complete replacement of the bridge decking on both bridges. These two bridges are about 25 years old.

Hartzell shared information regarding the planned Rock Island to Jamaica link which includes extended trail and a bridge over the active BNSF Railroad.

Hartzell was asked how the public is informed about trail closures and projects. The Parks website has a Trail page which lists active and future trail projects and long term closures. Facebook is used to alert riders to closures and as the primary information source for short term closures. The City issues press releases whenever informed of a closure. These can be found on the City's webpage and are also picked up by print and television media.

Hartzell will provide a link to the Wilderness Park Community Working Group website so the PBAC can review the results of that process.
