Trees may no longer be planted under power lines.

Trees that will NOT be permitted as street trees:

All Poplars, Ash, Non-Approved Elms, Buckeye, Silver Maple, Pecan, Horsechestnut, Pin Oak, Mulberry, Cypress Flowering Pear, Russian Olive, Willow, Cottonwood, Birch, Tree of Heaven (Alianthus), Evergreens, Walnut and Box Elder

SUBSTITUTIONS

Each street in Lincoln is assigned a tree species. Street tree planting permits identify a recommended tree species. from Parks & Recreation Staff.
