The Committee is asked to consider and offer advice on two redevelopment projects this month, both by WRK Ltd., represented by BVH Architects.

Item #2 is the is a redevelopment project which proposes the renovation of portions of the Gallup/Misty's Building at 11th & P Street (built in 1912) and the extension of the Gallup Building to the north, replacing the structure (216 N. 11th) on that site. Burlinghof and Davis designed the Commercial Club Building in 1912.
