We have four applications for sidewalk vending carts. The permitting ordinance for this use of the public sidewalks requires a report from Urban Design Committee as to the “appropriateness of the design and materials of the pushcart or stand.” (LMC 14.55.050 I believe this is generally intended to protect against permitting of haphazard or offensive appearing carts.


