(and JoAnne & Michelle P, FYI),



- Ill Landmark Center (1128 Lincoln Mall, 11th – 12th Sts)



- UNL entrance/"precinct" markers on City Campus (14th & R) and East Campus (Holdrege at Idylwild) etc



Considered in past years, deferred for future consideration (?)

- *The Farmers Mutual Building on 13th Street, K to Lincoln Mall*
 - *Perhaps including their parking lot/structure west of the building, and maybe even the parking*



area on the NW corner of 12th & K.

- *Roundabout sculptures—Paley's "Reflection" at 9th and Pinnacle Bank Arena Drive roundabout*



- *&/or Catherine Feguson's "Mbera" at 33rd & Sheridan*



(shown in former location on Woods Park)

- *Streetscape improvements on S. 48th & Prescott St. in the College View business area*
- *S. 11th Street ROW improvements*

- Centennial Mall
- N St. "cycletrack"
