Firecracker! Firecracker! Boom, Boom, Boom!!!

If fireworks are legal to buy where you live and you choose to use them, be sure to follow the following safety tips:

- Never allow young children to handle fireworks
- Never use fireworks while impaired by drugs or alcohol
- Older children should use them only under close adult supervision
- Anyone using fireworks or standing nearby should wear protective eyewear
- Never light them indoors
- Only use them away from people, houses and flammable material
- Only light one device at a time and maintain a safe distance after lighting
- Never ignite devices in a container
- Do not try to re-light or handle malfunctioning fireworks
- Soak unused fireworks in water for a few hours before discarding
- Keep a bucket of water nearby to fully extinguish fireworks that don't go off or in case of fire
- Better yet, grab a blanket and a patch of lawn, kick back and let the experts handle the show!

Noise and safety complaints lead to high volume of calls to the 911 Communications Center. It is LEGAL to use fireworks in Lincoln on July 3rd (8am-11:00pm) and July 4th (8am-11:59pm)

Call 911 in an emergency situation. Is there imminent danger? Is this in-progress/happening now? Is someone hurt? Could the problem escalate?
