70TH STREET, VAN DORN TO EASTBOROUGH PAVEMENT REPAIR PROJECT

Pre-construction Open House: June 11, 2015

The City of Lincoln will begin construction the week of June 22, 2015 on a concrete pavement repair and pedestrian signal replacement project along 70th Street between Van Dorn Street and Eastborough Lane. Please refer to the map on the back of this mailer for limits of repair work and location of pedestrian signal replacement.

Intent of Project: This is a pavement preservation project intended to maintain and improve the driving surface of the existing roadway facility. The need for the improvement is based upon information from the City of Lincoln's Pavement Management System (overall condition rating) and visual inspections by City staff. The existing pedestrian signal near 70th Street and Lincolnshire Road is reaching the end of its useful life and needs to be replaced. Pedestrian curb ramps that do not meet current Federal and local standards would be reconstructed to meet those standards.

Scope of Work: Construction will include repairing or removing and replacing deteriorated concrete panels, joints and curbs; and sealing cracks. Other work includes removing and replacing damaged storm sewer inlet tops, curb ramps that do not meet Federal and local standards, and the existing pedestrian crossing signal near 70th Street and Lincolnshire Road. Grinding of the pavement to remove irregularities and to improve smoothness will also be included with the project.

Estimated Construction Schedule: Construction will begin the week of June 22, 2015 and be completed by October 2016. All lanes will be open during the winter months.

Proposed Accommodation of Traffic During Construction: The City intends to complete the majority of the work using lane closures, allowing 70th Street to stay open during construction. However, to accommodate access needs or expedite completion of the work, there may be times when the contractor will be allowed to temporarily close portions of 70th Street and/or intersecting streets overnight to complete specific repairs, as determined by pavement conditions at the time of construction. "A" Street will be closed at the 70th Street intersection for three days for intersection repairs; however, 70th Street will remain open. Traffic will be temporarily detoured during those times but emergency access will be maintained at all times. Access to businesses and residences will be maintained but may be limited at times. Pedestrians and bicyclists may be directed to alternate crossings while the pedestrian signal is out of service, while repairs are made in crosswalks and during curb ramp reconstruction at sidewalks and bike paths.

Right-of-Way: All work will take place within existing right-of-way and easements.


