The City of Lincoln is hosting an informational open house regarding the Vine Street Resurfacing Project. This project includes asphalt mill and overlay, concrete base and curb repair and curb ramp reconstruction, as well as partial reconstruction of the intersections at 33rd St., 45th St., and 48th St.. Each of the partial reconstructions of intersections will involve a street closure with detours to through traffic. Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin Monday, May 23rd, 2016. MTZ Construction will be the contractor.
