CREEK STABILIZATION PROJECT

COLONIAL HILLS PARK CREEK PROJECT

The Watershed Management Division of the Public Works & Utilities Department and the Parks & Recreation Department will soon be finalizing a contract with Gana Trucking and Excavating to begin renovation work on the creek through Colonial Hills Park. After the contract is finalized, work should begin as soon as possible thereafter, weather permitting. Construction should be wrapped by spring of 2007 with the installation of new landscaping. The goal of this project is to reduce the erosion problems, improve water quality and direct overflow away from the playground area. This will be done by stabilizing the channel banks, constructing small grade control structures and creating a water quality cell near the north end of the park. A map of the area with the plans for rehabilitation and project contacts can be found on the opposite side of this page.

This project is a part of the Rain to Recreation program. Rain to Recreation is a watershed approach to reduce flooding, protect water quality and natural areas, and provide for recreational and educational opportunities.
