

# TRANSIT DEVELOPMENT PLAN



The City is developing a Transit Development Plan (TDP) to guide the delivery of public transit services over the next five years. StarTran is working with the City-County Planning Department on this effort.

An integral part of this study is a detailed public involvement effort that will include open houses, stakeholder meetings, online community forum where participants can share their ideas and identify opportunities for improvement, and meetings of the TDP Advisory Committee. The TDP Advisory Committee includes StarTran Advisory Board members and other individuals representing a range of community interests.

To determine how effectively existing transit services are serving the needs of Lincoln residents, the project will include a comprehensive evaluation of the current route design, service levels, ridership and customer amenities.

The City is being assisted by Nelson-Nygaard, a Seattle firm specializing in alternative transportation. The plan review process will take place in May and June, followed by more public open houses in September. This study is scheduled to be completed by December 2015, and changes would be implemented in the summer and fall of 2016.
