Door-to-door public rural transportation, serving the entire Lancaster County area plus the communities of Adams, Ceresco, Cortland, Eagle and Greenwood. Wheelchair accessible. Cost is \$2 one-way, \$4 round trip and \$20 for a ten-punch rider card. In Lincoln, transfers are available upon request. Morning pick ups and mid-day transfers are available with afternoon returns. Call to schedule trips as least one day in advance.

Cab coupon subsidy program sponsored by the American Council of the Blind of Nebraska, Lincoln Chapter. You must live in Lincoln city limits, have visual impairment or be blind. You will need to have an application completed and signed by a physician or N.C.B.V.I. counselor. You will receive tickets valued at \$200. You pay \$100.

For medical appointments only. They will schedule your trip with a local transportation provider. You must call the transportation company or your Medicaid health plan to schedule your pick-up and return trip rides. You must call at least 3-days in advance to schedule a ride.

When you call, they will need the following:

- Name
- Date of birth
- Medicaid number
- Your address and destination address
- Appointment time

They will also need to know:

- Use a walker or wheelchair
- Use a medical escort
- Have special directions and instructions
- Are in an authorized Personal Assistance Service (PAS) plan

Free transportation to and from medical appointments related to cancer treatment. Sponsored by the American Cancer Society. Not wheelchair accessible. This type of transportation is for cancer patients only and they must live in Lincoln. Call 72 hours in advance for reservations. Patient must be ambulatory.

Senior Saver/Go For Less Cash Fare

Reduced bus fares on fixed-route buses are available to people age 62 and over and disabled persons. Senior Saver, Go-For-Less, Medicare, State ID; or driver's license must be presented when boarding the bus. Cost is only 85 cents or a 20-ride pass for \$16.
